Artwork may include: painting, drawing, sculpture, pottery, poetry, photography, quilting, etc. (Sorry, no performing arts at this time!)

Submission Instructions:

- Artists may submit up to 5 works of art. The Selection Committee will select no more than 2 from each artist due to space limitations.
- Pictures of your original pieces **must** be emailed to jenifer.randle@okddc.ok.gov by **Feb. 1, 2013** in the form of a jpg, jpeg, png, gif, pdf or a word file **WITH an attached art entry form**.
- All artwork, including sculpture, must not exceed 20 pounds. Unfired clay sculptures will not be accepted.

Display Requirements:

- All entries **must** be signed in and out by the person responsible for the art. Artists should plan on bringing their artwork to the Governor's Conference, Embassy Suites in Norman, OK between 8:30-10:00am on March 5. Artwork will be displayed during the length of the conference, with pick up of artwork on March 6, between 1:00-3:00pm. Anything not picked up by 3:00pm, will be taken to the ODDC office.
- Each entry **must** have the artist's first and last name and the title of the piece on the back.
- Artists are responsible for preparing artwork to be placed on an easel. Please remember that a piece of paper cannot stand on an easel. Work should be mounted on foam board or framed. This includes poetry too.
