

Oklahoma Transition Council: *A Brief History*

In 2004, the Oklahoma Transition Council (OTC) formally developed and has since:

- Established local teams statewide;
- Provided professional development to increase transition education for educators, related service providers, parents, students, and other providers;
- Provided technical assistance to teams; and
- Sponsored follow-up team meetings.

Over the past seven years, the OTC has provided educational opportunities and support to over 3,500 professionals and 35 teams across Oklahoma, in collaboration with the National Secondary Transition Technical Assistance Center (NSTTAC).

The mission of the Oklahoma Transition Council is to improve transition education, planning, and services that lead to successful post-school outcomes for students with disabilities.

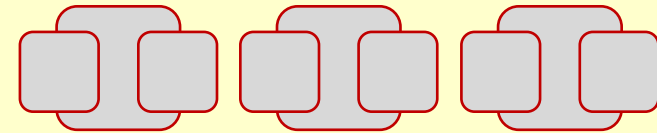
Goals
