- Learn more about disabilities and the services that people with disabilities receive

Who are Sibshops for? Sibshops are for 6 to 13-year-old brothers and sisters of children who have special needs.

Who sponsors Sibshops? Sibshops are a collaborative effort of J.D. McCarty Center, the Oklahoma Developmental Disability Council and the Oklahoma Family Network.

Who runs Sibshops? Our Sibshops are run by a team of people who have professional and, in some cases, a personal understanding of the impact a child’s special need can have on brothers and sisters. Equally important, they all have great kid skills!

When and where are Sibshops held? We will meet at the J.D. McCarty Center (Gymnasium) located at 2002 East Robinson Street, Norman, Oklahoma 73071.
