SUBJECT: OK EdPlan Special Education Data and Eligibility/IEP Process System

Oklahoma will be moving to a new Special Education data and eligibility/IEP Process system beginning July 1, 2015. The new contract vendor will be Public Consulting Group (PCG). The program is entitled OK EdPlan.

OK EdPlan will be available for districts free of charge for the use of documenting eligibility and plan management such as Individualized Education Programs (IEPs), Section 504 Accommodation Plan, and Individualized Service Plan (ISP). Regardless of the type of program utilized, districts will be required to upload all data required by the Oklahoma State Department of Education - Special Education Services (OSDE-SES) to the OK EdPlan site, such as October 1 child count information.

Earlier this year three "Sneak Peek" sessions were available to preview the new Special Education data and eligibility/IEP Process system. The webinars were recorded and are now available at http://www.ok.gov/sde/special-education along with a question and answer document. The "Sneak Peek" sessions provide an overview of OK EdPlan. Additional trainings will be available throughout the summer prior to the 2015-16 school year.
