**RE:** Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Uniform Grant Guidance (UGG)

On December 26, 2013, the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) published new guidance for Federal award programs, <u>OMB Uniform Guidance</u>: <u>Administrative Requirements</u>, <u>Cost Principles</u>, and <u>Audit Requirements for Federal Awards</u> to deliver on the promise of a 21<sup>st</sup> Century government that is more efficient. This reform of OMB guidance will reduce administrative burden for non-federal entities receiving federal awards while reducing the risk of waste, fraud and abuse.

Final Guidance has been issued that, upon implementation, will supersede requirements from OMB Circulars A-21, A-87, A-110, and A-122 (which have been placed in 2 C.F.R. Parts 220, 225, 215, and 230); Circulars A-89, A-102, and A-133; and the guidance in Circular A-50 on Single Audit Act follow-up. See <u>final guidance</u> for more information.
