District Test Coordinators,

The Office of Accountability and Assessments in conjunction with our testing vendor CTB/McGraw-Hill will be offering a prior form of the Oklahoma Modified Alternate Assessment Program (OMAAP) End-of-Instruction (EOI) test for Biology I and U.S. History during the Spring test administration window. These tests will be aligned to the previous PASS standards that were taught through the 2011-2012 school year. The purpose of these tests is to allow seniors a retake opportunity in either content area so that a Modified Proficiency Score may be applied prior to the end of May. These tests should ONLY be administered to seniors on an IEP who qualify for the OMAAP assessment and who completed instruction in these content areas prior to the 2012-2013 school year.

The Office of Accountability and Assessments will need to approve your student list in order for these tests to be ordered through our testing vendor, CTB.

A file layout is attached for you to fill out and then submit to our email assessment folder at the following address: Assessments@sde.ok.gov.

After the file is approved, the state will submit it directly to CTB for your order to be processed and then shipped to your district for the Spring administration. These tests will be named OMAAP Biology I or OMAAP U.S. History Senior Retake. Caution should be taken that the Senior Retake tests are not confused with the Spring OMAAP Biology I and U.S. History tests that first time testers will be administered that align to the new Oklahoma C3 Standards.

These tests should be administered during the Spring paper/pencil EOI testing window, April 15 – May 3, 2013, using the Test Administration Manuals which will be provided with your other EOI OMAAP tests. These forms will be available for the Spring administration only. They are NOT available in large-print, Braille, or equivalent forms. CTB will provide communication to districts regarding instructions for returning these test materials.
