The 2013 camp will be filled with exciting and challenging activities. Everyone will work with a partner, but to improve social skills, those partners will change twice each day. We believe it will be a fun time for all.

Applications will be accepted from Feb. 4 - April. 30. Late applications may not be accepted due to limited numbers. Come join the fun!

The following information will clarify some of your questions:

- High School Camp: June 16-21, age limits 12-17.
- Elementary Camp: June 23-26, age limits 6-11.
- Busing is provided to and from camp from specific points to be posted online at a later date.
- No staff is available to handle students who have need of constant one on one physical, emotional, or medical supervision.
- We will accept a few adults as volunteer aids if you would like to be a part of your child's camp. Fill out the proper [Volunteer Form](#). Volunteers are responsible for costs and finger printing before acceptance consideration.
- All forms are printable for your convenience. Be sure to fill out forms completely, and mail or fax back only the forms that are marked.
- There is no cost for the camp !!! Just spending money for arcades and food at Lazer Zone.
- **Yes, feel free to make copies and give to other parents of deaf or hard of hearing children who want to come to camp.**

Here is what to expect for your child:

- A great learning experience - both academically and socially.
- Professional staff whose heart is to help your child grow in a positive atmosphere.
- 24 hour supervision including day-time nursing and night-time on-call care.
- Fun classroom learning and leadership activities that include a half day with the Rotary Leaders Club, at

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Student Behavior Expectations During Summer Camp

PURPOSE: This camp will give students an opportunity to improve their skills in social and academic areas. We expect all the students to behave in a respectful manner toward each other and toward all staff members.

General Camp Rules:

- Be responsible
- Be punctual
- Be cooperative
- Respect the rights and property of others
- Be safety conscious
- Obey state and federal laws
- Phone calls are on a "Collect Call Only" basis.
- Cell phone use is limited to 1 hour at night in the dorms.
- Day students will turn in car keys upon arrival, and they will be returned when student leaves for home that night.
- Local students are allowed to stay in the dorms on a full-time basis only. They may not stay part-time in the dorms. This is to insure accountability and safety at all times.
- **All medications** will be turned in to designated staff for controlled distribution. This includes over-the-counter drugs.
- **No camper will be allowed to register if we do not have complete medical information and a copy of medical insurance card.**



The following are prohibited on OSD campus:

Cigarettes, drugs, alcohol, weapons, sexual relations, leaving campus (unless in a supervised activity), driving personal vehicles except to arrive in the morning and leave in the evening (local students only).

ANY BEHAVIOR DEEMED UNACCEPTABLE WILL RESULT IN PARENTAL CONTACT AND, AT PARENTS' EXPENSE, STUDENT WILL BE PICKED UP BY PARENTS AND TAKEN HOME IMMEDIATELY.

- All bedding is supplied, but you may want to bring your own pillow.
- Swimming trunks and towels: Two piece suits require an outer covering.
- Money – For Arcade and Food at Lazor Zone only. (SCHOOL TAKES NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOST MONEY)
- Comfortable summer shorts and shirts. Please, no revealing garments.
- A great attitude and a desire to learn and have fun together.
