2015-2016 FIRST/OSDE Partnership Grant Rules and Guidelines

The State Board of Education has approved a competitive grant that was awarded to *FIRST* for \$70,000 in order to help support public school student participation in the For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and Technology Robotics Programs (*FIRST*). The *FIRST* will provide grants up to \$6,000 per school to facilitate both recent start-up and existing team opportunities.

Eligible recipient: Oklahoma public K-12 schools including charter schools

Grant funds may be used for:

- FIRST Lego League (FLL)
- FIRST Tech Challenge (FTC)
- FIRST Robotics Competition (FRC) teams

Allowable uses of funds include:

- FIRST competition registration fees
- Needed or necessary equipment related to FIRST competitions
- Other costs associated with direct participation in any of the FIRST Programs

Funds available: NOTE: Grants will be awarded directly and electronically to the winning school team account located at FIRST Finance.

Applicants are eligible to apply for grants in the following amounts.

Recent start-up Teams (1st and 2nd year teams)

FLL –\$225 (team registration only)

FTC – up to \$500 (team registration and or team operations)

FRC – up to \$6,000 (team registration and or team operations)

<u>Veteran Teams (3rd thru 5th year teams)</u>

FLL –\$225 (team registration only)

FTC – up to \$500 (team registration and or team operations)

FRC – up to \$6,000 (team registration and or team operations)

Successful applications will address:

- Oklahoma Academic Standards in Science, and Math connections http://ok.gov/sde/oklahoma-academic-standards
- Increased student engagement in STEM education through FIRST Competitions.
- Demonstrate commitment to the development of student teams of all learning levels, recruitment of volunteer mentors/industry specialists, exploring

- engineering design through robotics.
- A FIRST Team temporary team number identified
- Participate in a Oklahoma FIRST Competition. Information on competitions and registration can be found in the Timeline of FIRST Events in this document.

Application Process:

- Complete a grant application form online.
- Submit application(s) online, and email signed assurance, Temporary or permanent Team number and a signed school IRS form W-9 via email
- Grants will be evaluated by the OSDE and FIRST partnership committee members
- Grant award notification letter will be sent to the FIRST Coach identified in the application via email from FIRST in Oklahoma:
 - o FLL and FTC announcement: August 31, 2015
 - o FRC announcement: October 1, 2015
- All Award funds will be credited to the team account at FIRST Finance and official notification notices will be emailed.
 - o FLL and FTC official notification to be emailed in September 2015
 - FRC official notification to be emailed in October 2015
