REAC³H Network State Role

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REAC³H Network State Role

- Provide technical support
- Develop and sustain REAC³H Teacher Advisory group
- Seek incentives for REAC³H Network districts:
 - Grant opportunities
 - Pilot programs



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REAC³H Network District Role

- Serve as a lead district in the REAC³H Network
- Develop a detailed regional plan for implementing CCSS with assigned districts
 - Identify training timeline and delivery methods
 - Develop partnerships to coordinate a training network
 - Enlist higher education and CareerTech
 - Describe how capacity-building would look in area served



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REAC³H Network District Role

- Host regular meetings based on OSDE guidelines
- Provide OSDE-developed training on CCSS and other related topics
- Disseminate professional development (tools, resources, model curricula, etc.) to area districts



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REAC³H Network District Role

- Collect data on implementation effectiveness
- Submit annual report on REAC³H activities, participation, and implementation
- Other appropriate responsibilities, as defined by districts
