


Step 1. Child is identified as possibly needing special education and related services




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Step 1. Child is identified as possibly needing special education and related services

Step 2. Child is evaluated




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Step 3. Eligibility is decided

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
Individualized Education Program

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Basics about the IEP




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- Individualized
- Written plan for a child's education
- Written by parents and school staff together
- Lists the special education the child will receive, and more
- Is both a document and a process



Acronyms Defined


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Least Restrictive Environment

Children with disabilities are to be educated with children who do not have disabilities, to the maximum extent appropriate






