Page 75	<p>The design and implementation of the Transformation Model for Butner Elementary specifies providing staff with ongoing, high-quality, job embedded professional development. We have evaluated the services received the past two years, and moving into the last year of the grant, we feel our teachers are well versed in academic vocabulary which was the emphasis of Dr. Taylor's presentations. Therefore, for 2014-2015, we would like to continue with professional development that supports previous years and fills gaps in areas in which we feel need improvement.</p> <p>We would like to have additional mathematics professional development through the Ron and Nancy Brown's Creative Mathematics training for our elementary teachers. The cost of this workshop that is being held on a scheduled day out of school is \$11,000.</p> <p>We would like to complete our Promethean training with the second part that incorporates iPads with our new boards for a cost of \$4250.</p> <p>To help improve specific reading skills, a 2-day training by the 95% Group, a reading remediation program, will help our teachers fill specific skill gaps as well as promote continuity. The cost of this training will be \$6630.</p>

	<p>Motivational and team building training with Dr. Adolf Brown which includes books will cost \$13,345.</p> <p>We need additional days to help support teachers' needs through the one-on-one assistance provided by our instructional coach which would cost \$10,800.</p> <p>End of the year data review and book study will cost \$16,762.81.</p> <p>Butner would like to amend the technology budget of \$91,418.59 and reduce it by \$62,787.81 to provide professional development and supplemental materials listed in this amendment.</p>

<p>Page 77</p>	<p>Butner Elementary School is requesting to amend the 2014-2015 SMART goal based on the percent proficient on the Oklahoma Core Curriculum Test (OCCT) using the performance index.</p> <p>Reading SMART Goal Based on the preliminary release of Oklahoma Core Curriculum Test (OCCT) data, Butner Elementary School will increase the percent proficient for all students in reading from an F in the 2013-2014 school year to a D or better in the 2014-2015 school year.</p> <p>Mathematics SMART Goal Based on the preliminary release of Oklahoma Core Curriculum Test (OCCT) data, Butner Elementary School will increase the percent proficient for all students in mathematics from an F in the 2013-2014 school year to a D or better in the 2014-2015 school year.</p> <p>If Butner Elementary School meets the SMART goal in reading, all certified staff members will receive a one-time stipend of \$2,000. and noncertified staff will receive a one-time stipend of \$500.</p> <p>If Butner Elementary School meets the SMART goal in</p>

	<p>mathematics, all certified staff members will receive a one-time stipend of \$2,000 and noncertified staff will receive a one-time stipend of \$500.</p> <p>In addition to the stipend for increasing a letter grade in reading and mathematics, each certified teacher would receive a one-time stipend of \$5.00 for every advanced and proficient indicator on the OCCT tests for reading and mathematics. We have set the bar so high in the past two years, that we have not been able to pay any incentive funds to our hard working teachers. Awarding this goal at this time may also assist with teacher retention.</p> <p>Butner's existing incentive budget already included \$79,526.82. Butner would like to amend the supplemental materials budget of \$90,668.50 and reduce it by \$70,668.50. In addition, technology budget will be reduced by \$7,808.17 and the unbudgeted amount of \$10,190.20 will be added to provide the amount required to pay for the requested changes listed in this amendment.</p> <p>Funds budgeted to all expenditures in this amendment were taken from the technology budget and the supplemental materials budget leaving \$20,822.61 in technology and \$20,000 in supplemental materials.</p>
