


OAAP Weekly Update

The 2014-15 Oklahoma Alternate Assessment Program (OAAP) will utilize two different assessment systems. Science and social studies will be assessed through Portfolio/PearsonAccess. The subject areas of math and English/Language Arts will be assessed through the Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM) Alternate Assessment System.

Operational Spring Window

The Spring Operational Window for Dynamic Learning Maps is OPEN. It is scheduled to close May 1.

Rosters

IMPORTANT DLM has notified OSDE that a small number of school districts have uploaded students into Educator Portal, but have yet to create rosters for their students. Students cannot be tested until a roster has been created for them. CREATE/REVIEW STUDENT ROSTERS.

Special Note: High school students must be assigned a course; verify high school students are enrolled in the correct course. These courses are specific to the End-of-Instruction assessment(s) the student will be administered. (See picture below)

DLM Testing Timeline

The estimated total testing time it will take for a student to complete the mathematics assessments is 35-60 minutes; the estimated total testing time for English language arts is 70-90 minutes. All testlets must be completed within the testing window. Students will receive 4-7 testlets for each subject area. Each testlet contains 3-5 items. (Please see the chart below.)

Testlet Information Pages (TIPs)

Testlet Information Pages (TIPs) provide test administrators with information specific to each testlet. Test administrators receive a TIP page after each test is assigned to a student. Materials for Testlets

The materials listed on the Testlet Information Pages (TIPs) are very flexible. When finding a substitute manipulative, it is important to match key attributes of the objects in order to ensure they meet the general requirement for that Essential Element.

Materials should be collected prior to the test session. If you begin a testlet and the objects and materials listed are not working as anticipated, use the “exit does not save” option to leave the test. You may log back in at a later time after you have collected different materials. If substitute objects are close by, you may not need to log out. The system can remain inactive for up to 28 minutes.

Portfolio Administration (Science, History, and Geography)

DLM Science Pilot Test Window

The Oklahoma Alternate Assessment Program (OAAP) will utilize the Dynamic Learning Maps assessment system to assess science for the 2015-16 school year. To better prepare for the 2015-16 science assessment, OSDE is encouraging all districts to participate in the optional DLM Science Pilot Test April 22 – May 22, 2015. If your district is planning to participate, students must 1) qualify for the OAAP; and 2) have a roster created for the subject area of Science. Testlets will automatically generate once the Pilot Test Window opens.

- The DLM and Portfolio Operational Spring Windows close May 1.
- Test administrators are required to complete the DLM training modules prior to administering assessments.
