

## 2016-17 OAAP Weekly Update (9-20-16)

To ensure students with significant cognitive disabilities are provided with appropriate state assessments, the Oklahoma Alternate Assessment Program (OAAP) mirrors the general assessment in regards to grades and subjects assessed.

The 2016-17 OAAP will utilize two different assessment systems. High School US History will be assessed through Portfolio/PearsonAccess. The subject areas of math, science and English/Language Arts will be assessed through the Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM) Alternate Assessment System. ### **KITE Client 3.0 Release and Service Desk Open Forum Sessions**

On September 19, 2016 KITE® Client 3.0 was released and made available for download. **It is required that all testing devices must be updated to the new KITE Client in order to deliver the DLM alternate assessment for the 2016-17 school year.** You will not be able to administer any tests on previous versions of KITE Client. The 3.0 download, instructions, and a list of supported platforms can be found [here](#). Installation and updates are typically handled by your local technology personnel. Please note that **Windows users MUST delete older KITE® Client folders** from your Program Files (x86) folder before installing version 3.0.

In an effort to provide support to districts when installing KITE® Client 3.0, the DLM Service Desk will host two open forum sessions for users who require assistance during the install. The first forum session is September 19–21 and the second session is September 26–28 from 8–5 Central Time. ### **2015-2016 DLM Scores Available Via EdPlan Soon**

In an effort to assist school districts with their data needs, the OSDE-SES will be providing the DLM scores in a CSV format. The CSV spreadsheets will be uploaded into the documents section of the student named “Data Test” in the EdPlan system by October 16, 2016. More information and instructions on accessing the spreadsheets will be coming soon.

### **Duplicate Student Test Score Reports**

There have been reports of duplicate student test score reports in the DLM Educator Portal System. If a student changed teachers or were rostered to multiple teachers during the school year, even if only rostered to one teacher at a time, then there will be more than one report. However, the reports should be identical.

### **DLM System Technical Issues**

Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM) has identified that the district-level student (bundled) reports are currently unavailable and is working diligently to correct the issue. The student (individual) reports are available as normal. We thank you for your patience and will update you as soon as the issue is resolved.

### **2015-2016 Pearson Portfolio Student Reports**

The 2015-2016 Pearson portfolio scores are currently available in the Accountability (A-F Report Cards) application in Single Sign On and in the PearsonAccess Next site at <https://ok.pearsonaccessnext.com/customer/index.action>.

### **2015-2016 DLM End-of -Year Assessment Student Reports**

The 2015-2016 DLM student reports will be available for download from Educator Portal on August 31, 2016 at <https://educator.cete.us/AART/login.htm>. These reports present the student's results from the DLM assessments from the 2015-2016. It is important that school districts retrieve student reports as quickly as possible to share with parents. The student reports can be downloaded as individual student reports or bundled student reports and will only be available until June 30, 2017. Student scores can also be found in the Accountability (A-F Report Cards) application in Single Sign On.

#### ***VIEW STUDENT YEAR END REPORTS***


Each state will determine which role has access to individual and bundled Student Year End Reports.

These reports are the student's assessment reports that present an overview of the student's results from the year's DLM assessments.


1. Click **Reports**.




- Under Alternate Assessments and Year End, select either **Student (Individual)** or **Students (Bundled)**. These selections will only be visible to those who have access.



- From the drop-down menus, select the District, School, Subject, and Grade.



- For individual student reports, choose the student's name and click **View Report**.



For bundled student reports, select the district and school from the drop-down menus to gain access to PDF files for individual grades, which can then be saved locally.
