WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

A teaching assistant with at least one year of experience in a public school

A public school paraprofessional is an employee of a school district whose position is either instructional in nature, or who delivers other direct services to students and/or their parents. A public school paraprofessional serves in a position for which a teacher or another professional has the ultimate responsibility for the design, implementation, and evaluation of the individual educational programs or related services and student performance. 70 O.S. § 159.1

The Oklahoma State Department of Education (OSDE) shall issue a one-year provisional certificate, renewable for up to three years, for early childhood, or elementary education, or special education to a paraprofessional who meets the following requirements:

Bachelor's Degree from an Accredited College (cumulative GPA 2.5 req.)



At Least one year of continuous employment as a paraprofessional in a Public School accredited by the State Board of Education in the Area being pursued.



- Pass the General Education Test (OGET), Oklahoma Professional Teaching Exam (OPTE), and Oklahoma Subject Area Test (OSAT) in Early Childhood Education, or Elementary Education, or Special Education
 - > OSAT must be in the area your public school experience was earned.
- Pass the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) criminal history record check

OSDE Issues provisional certificate to be Eligible for Employment (with app & \$10 fee)

(Valid for One Year – May Be Renewed Up to Three Years)



Within three (3) years, complete twelve (12) semester hours of professional education coursework from a higher education institution accredited by the Oklahoma Commission for Teacher Preparation with an approved program in the certification area held. The twelve (12) semester hours must include a minimum of three (3) semester hours in reading instruction.



After one year of continuous employment in a Public School accredited by the State Board of Education in the area earned, submit 2 favorable recommendations for a standard certificate, one from the district board of education and one from the chair/director of education from the program the 12 hrs. were completed.



Standard Teaching Certificate (with app and \$50 fee)
