State Approved Assessments

At this time, the following RSA screening assessments are in effect.

These were approved by the State Board of Education on April 25, 2013, for use at the beginning of the school year, for monitoring of progress, and for measurement of reading skills at the end of the school year:

Alternative Assessments

The following are approved alternative standardized reading assessments that may be used to justify a good cause promotion pursuant to 70 O.S. § 1210.508C(K)(3). The listed score constitutes an acceptable level of performance, and the student must score at or above the following percentiles:

- Stanford Achievement Test, Tenth Edition, (SAT 10), **45th Percentile**
- Iowa Test of Basic Skills (ITBS) Complete Battery Form A, C or E, Level 9, Reading Comprehension, **45th Percentile**
- Iowa Test of Basic Skills (ITBS) Core Battery, Form A, C, or E, Level 9, Reading Comprehension, **45th Percentile**
- Terranova, Third Edition Complete Battery Level 13, Reading, **45th Percentile**

Diagnostic Assessments

Throughout the year progress monitoring shall continue, and diagnostic assessment, if determined appropriate, shall be provided. Year-end reading skills shall be measured to determine reading success. (70 O.S. § 1210.508C) The approved diagnostic assessments are:

- Diagnostic Assessment of Reading (DAR)
- Developmental Reading Assessment 2 (DRA 2)
- Group Reading Assessment and Diagnostic Evaluation (GRADE)
- Gray Oral Reading Test (GORT 4)
- Kaufman Test of Educational Achievement Second Edition
- Peabody Picture Vocabulary Test 4 (PPVT 4)
- Texas Primary Reading Inventory (TPRI)
- Woodcock-Johnson III Diagnostic Reading Battery (WJ-III)

Districts may utilize diagnostic assessments which are not on the approved list. However, Reading Sufficiency Act funds **may not be utilized** to purchase such assessments.
