Did you know there is an Oklahoma State Law on when children may be excluded from school? (310:520-1-4)

The superintendent, teacher, or other official in charge of any school may exclude any child suffering from or exhibiting the following symptoms:

1. fever alone, 100 degrees Fahrenheit;
2. sore throat or tonsillitis;
3. any eruption of the skin, or rash;
4. any nasal discharge accompanied by fever
5. a severe cough, producing phlegm; OR
6. any inflammation of the eyes or lids.
