Security Drills 70 O.S. § 5-148

- 4 per year, at a minimum
- To prevent or mitigate injuries or death that may result from a threat around in the school
- Timing
 - Cannot be at the same time of day as previous drill
 - One within 1st fifteen days of each semester
- Must conform to written plans and procedures
 - Requirements set forth in 63 O.S. § 681
- Everyone participates, incorporate law enforcement

Safety Drills 70 O.S. § 5-149

- In addition to *security* drills, conduct a minimum of 6 safety drills per year
 - 2 fire
 - 2 tornado
 - Remaining 2? Discretionary with a caveat
- Records to be preserved for at least three (3) years
 - Reports to be filed with School Security Institute

School Security Plans 63 O.S. § 681

- Each school must have written plan in place for “protecting students, faculty, visitors from natural and man-made disasters and emergencies.”
- Reviewed and updated annually
- On file at each school district and each local emergency response organization

Safe School Committee 70 O.S. § 24-100.5

- Composed of at least 7 members
 - Teachers, parents, students, school official responsible for investigating bullying reports
 - Assist in planning, implementing and evaluating effective prevention, readiness, and response
- Study and make recommendations regarding:
 - Unsafe conditions, possible intervention strategies
 - Student bullying
 - Professional development needs
 - Methods to encourage engagement of community and students

Certain Persons to Carry Handgun(s)

70 O.S. § 5-149.2

- Board of education may designate school personnel to carry a firearm
 - Local decision
 - Training requirements
 - Possess a handgun license
 - Carry on person or store in locked/secure location

School Security Institute

- Office of Homeland Security
- Central repository for schools to contact for information on resources to enhance security, assess risks and threats
- Goals/objectives include:
 - Maximizing school security training and support;
 - Assisting and coordinating in development and implementation of safety drills
 - Facilitate use of available programs or entities for training
 - Creating and coordinating working groups for new strategies and recommendations on school security issues



School Security Revolving Fund

- Yearly grants to schools
- Homeland Security to solicit proposals and make grants
- Goals/objectives include:
 - Increasing awareness to risks, threats, vulnerabilities
 - Incentivize participation in security training programs
 - Provide assistance to schools initiating and implementing plans and activities
- Annual Report
