

The second semester is off to a very strong start with students doing an amazing amount of math. Already, 27,052 students, accounting for over 55% of the TTM contract, have completed 5+ lessons during SY2013-2014. 5+ lessons is a key milestone on the TTM system as it indicates a level of engagement that leads to math score improvement. STUDENT MOTIVATION

The **Red River Rumble** is under way. This motivational program for students and teachers is a unique opportunity to do math and represent the state of Oklahoma against bitter rival Texas. Every week 5 classes earn the right to represent Oklahoma in a math showdown against 5 classes in Texas. The winners earn points that are totaled over the course of the entire contest.
