Teachers – if you are entering your students' posters in the Turn Around Don't Drown poster contest, the deadline for these entries is March 1. This contest is only open to fourth grade students at this time.

The rules for the poster contest are as follows:

- Use 8 ½" by 11" paper or poster board only.
- Must be original artwork.
- No copyrighted or syndicated characters (cartoons etc.).
- No computer or copy machine made graphics.
- Poster needs to be able to be reproduced well - bright colors and contrast.
- All posters are to be kept by the judges. The poster may be copied or reproduced.
- Print on the back of the poster Student's name, School name, Teacher's name, City, OFMA Region, School Address and phone number, Parent's name.

We need you to include a roster of all the students' names, school name, teachers name, City, OFMA Region, school address and school or teacher contact telephone number for all students who submitted a poster. Every student who participates will receive a certificate of appreciation. We have found it is sometimes difficult for us to read the student's handwriting.
