

#### **Test Fee Assistance Data**

3,535 students received test fee assistance representing 27.9% of all test takers

202 sites had students who received test fee assistance

Average test fee assistance per students \$152



### **Advanced Placement Summer Workshops**

Each year, the Oklahoma State Department of Education offers week-long summer workshops for teachers of Advanced Placement courses. The workshops provide guidance and resources for effective instructional practices to support students in being successful in Advanced Placement courses and on Advanced Placement exams. The workshops are facilitated by Northeastern State University and the University of Oklahoma.

#### **Cost Versus Benefits**

Oklahoma, public high school students earned **10,573** qualifying AP® scores of 3, 4, or 5 in 2020.

- These scores translate into 31,719 potential college credits.
- At a cost of \$307.67 per college credit, the potential tuition and fee savings to Oklahoma students and families is \$9,758,984.
