Resources for Data Privacy & Security

The Oklahoma State Department of Education provides the following list as a resource to help you stay informed of legislation impacting data privacy & security. The list is not intended to be comprehensive nor to serve as legal advice. It may, however, give you a general overview of legislation impacting data privacy and security.

- The <u>Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA)</u> (20 U.S.C. § 1232g; 34 CFR Part 99) is a Federal law that protects the privacy of student education records. The law applies to all schools that receive funds under an applicable program of the U.S. Department of Education.
- The <u>Protection of Pupil Rights Amendment (PPRA)</u> (20 U.S.C. § 1232h) governs the administration to students of a survey, analysis, or evaluation that relates to one or more of eight protected areas. It also involves marketing surveys and other areas of student privacy, parental access to information, and the administration of certain physical examinations to minors.
- The <u>Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA)</u> (16 CFR Part 312) imposes requirements on operators of websites or online services directed to children under 13 years of age by placing additional protections in place and parental controls.
- The <u>Children's Internet Protection Act (CIPA)</u> (47 U.S.C. § 254h) imposes requirements on schools and libraries to receive discounts offered by the E-rate program such as internet safety policies and education about appropriate online behavior.
- The Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA) was
 enacted to, among other things, establish national health care system standards
 and to protect the privacy and security of individually identifiable health
