

## Recycled Milk Log

Offer vs. Serve is only available for schools that have had no Seriously Deficiencies. When using offer verses serve, you must have this “recycled milk log” on file EVERYDAY for Each meal service.

For example, regardless of the sites trends you must always start meal service with the number of expected attendance. For example if you have an average of 50 children come to your site, you must have 50 milks available each day.

The food and milk are placed on a serving line and the children can pick the items. You must keep track of the milk and use this form, for every site every day. All recycled food items must be stored in accordance with local health codes, and must be documented. Recycled foods are only those foods that are not served. If the food is served, counted as a component in a reimbursable meal, part of the meal cannot then be returned to a share table and be reserved.

Sponsors should therefore maintain record of their daily use of purchased milk or other food items which are recycled. Section 210.8©, 220.11 (b), 225.9 (d (4) and 226.10 (c)
