 210:35-29-8. Requirements for alternative education programs [AMENDED]

Board member Price addressed the alternative education/definition, need for effective programs for disruptive students and nationwide data.

Superintendent Hofmeister concurred many students placed in alternative education are successful but an alternative education opportunity is not offered to all students. This is the reason State Board's 2019 Education Budget request includes \$40 million for student credit recovery, counseling; and even preventatives of disruptive behaviors by intersecting with Criminal Justice.
