210:20-9-94. Period of validity of certificates

(a) Standard certificates normally have a validity period of five (5) years. The standard certificate will expire five (5) years from the nearest thirtieth day of June either preceding or following the effective date of the certificate.

(b) A license normally has a validity period of one (1) school year. The license will expire the thirtieth day of June of the school year for which it was issued.

(eb) Provisional certificates, vocational and/or nonvocational, will have a validity period established by the State Department of Education.

 (\underline{dc}) Emergency certificates normally have a validity period of one (1) school year. The certificate will expire the thirtieth day of June of the school year for which it was issued. The validity period for an emergency certificate may be extended for one (1) additional school year at the request of the superintendent of the employing district, subject to the approval of the State Board of Education. The maximum validity period for an emergency certificate extended by State Board approval will be two (2) years.
