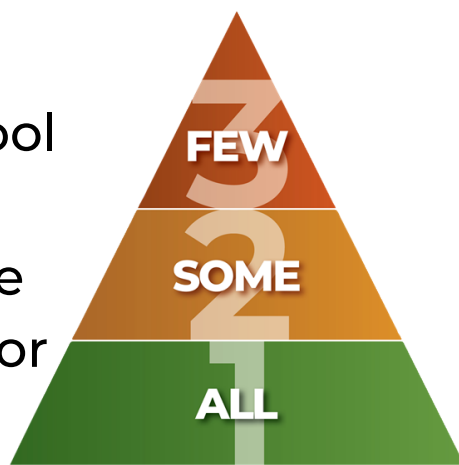


State Systemic Improvement Plan- Part B

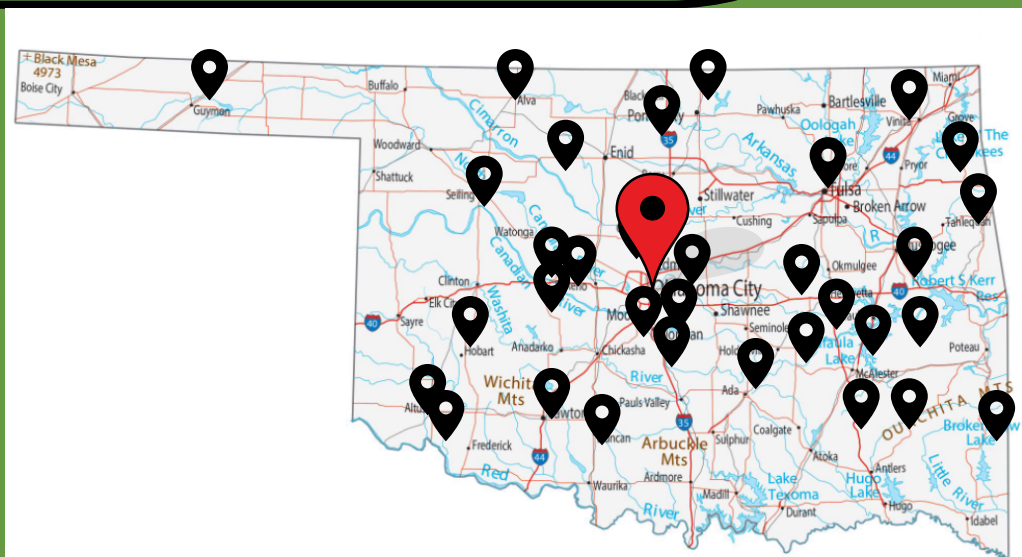

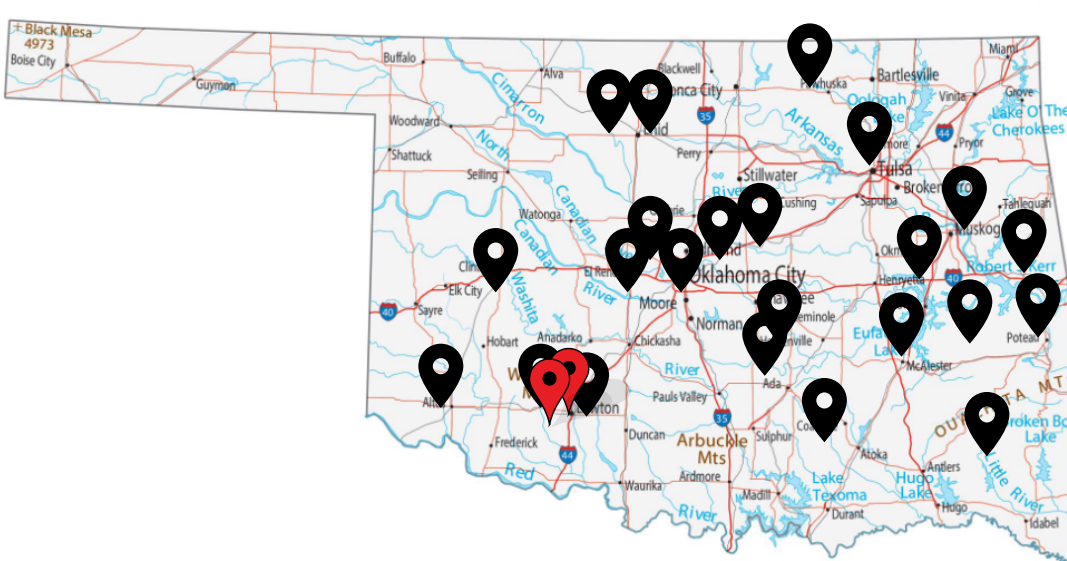
