October 1 Consolidated

- This report is live and due no later than October 31, 2023. No corrections to student data can be made after the due date. Certification of this report includes the Special Education Child Count Report.
- Please make sure your Child Count numbers match watch is being reported in the final report.
- If it doesn't match you will need to make the appropriate changes in your SIS and until it updates before you confirm a site.

Child Count

Lunch Determination Eligibility

- If you have a student who has an approved free application and is on the Direct Certification.
- The eligibility determination would be based on income, not the Direct Certification.

1.30 Lunch Eligibility Determination

Note: This is an Oklahoma SIF_ExtendedElement. Use State Department of Education Codes. This element answers the question, "How was this student identified as Free or Reduced?"

OSDE Code	OSDE Description
01	Identified through Direct Certification - SNAP Only
02	Identified as foster child (not subject to verification) – Foster Child who was directly certified.
03	Identified as foster child (categorically eligible) – Foster Child who was NOT directly certified.
04	Identified through homeless/migrant/runaway liaison list – Directly Certified
05	Identified through income-eligible Head Start
06	Identified through Even Start
07	Identified as residential students in RCCIs
08	Identified as non-applicants approved by local officials
09	Identified based on SNAP/TANF/FDPIR case number submitted on an application (categorically eligible)
10	Identified based on income/household size information submitted on an application (Do not include foster children).
12	Identified through Direct Certification – TANF Only
13	Identified through Direct Certification – FDPIR Only
14	Identified as Homeless, Migrant, Runaway based on Application (not directly certified)
15	Identified as Directly Certified Other (DO NOT INCLUDE these categories: SNAP, TANF, FDPIR, Foster, Homeless, Migrant, Runaway, Head Start, Even Start)
16	Identified through Direct Certification – Medicaid Only (This is a new code and should NOT overwrite SNAP or TANF)
OT	Identified in some other way other than listed above. ODSE does not ever expect to receive code OT for Lunch Eligibility Determination. This code is reserved for emergency legislative updates or mid-year policy changes and is not a valid for any other reason.
NA	The student is NOT eligible for Free or Reduced lunch

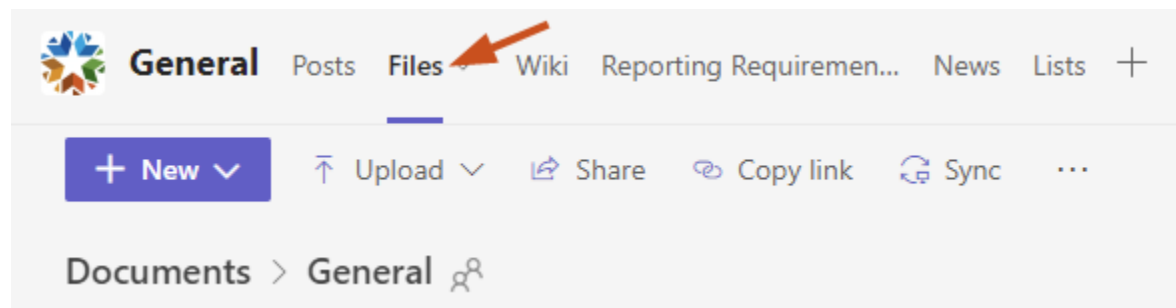

Civil Right Data Collection (CRDC)

- Districts may begin submitting data for school year 2021-2022 on Monday, December 11, 2023.
- The data submission period will end on Monday, February 26, 2024.
- As in previous years, the 2021–22 CRDC will be a universal collection in which every public school district and school in the country that receives federal financial assistance from the Department is required to participate.
- OSDE will host a training event to assist district users with this collection.
