Special Ed Corrections

- Districts may have or will be receiving notification within the next few days of conflicts with Special Education student status or Section 504 student status identified in the October 1 Consolidate Report.
- The conflicts are a result of the following:
 - the IEP status in the SIS did not match the status in EdPlan (Child Count),
 - the student was marked as IEP and Section 504
- The values for the listed STNs must be corrected in the SIS and corrected Values must be provided as a response to the notification by November 15, 2023. Please ensure the responsible staff member receives the STNs that are in conflict to resolve issues within the time frame.

- This session will present detailed instructions for working with students who need to complete graduation requirements along with best practices and guidance for completing the Graduation Part-time Report for quarters 1, 2, 3, and 4.

- The course is directed toward registrars, principals, counselors, and high school schedulers who are novice users.
- No updates for student data can be done after December 8, 2023.

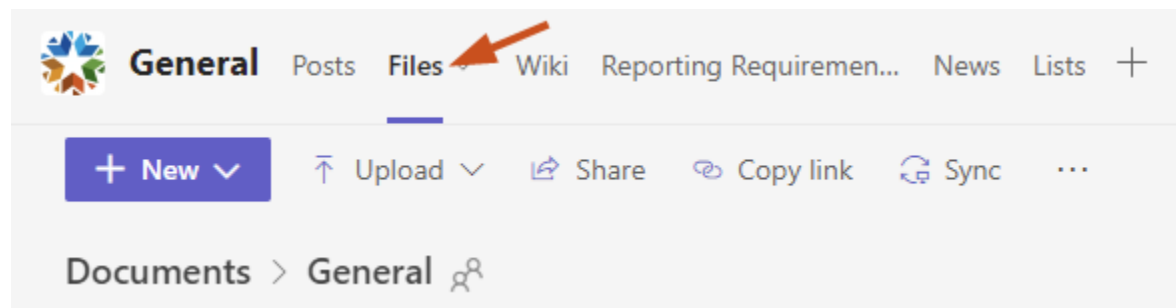
Civil Right Data Collection (CRDC)

- Districts may begin submitting data for school year 2021-2022 on Monday, December 11, 2023.
- The data submission period will end on Monday, February 26, 2024.
- As in previous years, the 2021–22 CRDC will be a universal collection in which every public school district and school in the country that receives federal financial assistance from the Department is required to participate.
- OSDE will host a training event to assist district users with this collection.
