Additionally, both the student's EL and IEP representative must agree that:

- The student possesses the level of English language proficiency necessary to ensure academic success without the provision of EL-specific supplemental services and supports.
- 2. The ongoing provision of EL-specific services and supports, as well as continued participation in the Alternate ACCESS for ELLs assessment, serves no educational benefits to the student beyond those met by those supports, accommodations, and modifications provided through the student's IEP.
