The following are the remaining questions and answers we received:

- Q.1. Per section A.37.2 and section A.49.2, please confirm that number of schools and districts as there are conflicts between these two sections.
- A.1. There are 539 school districts and 1,240 schools.
- Q.2.vPer section A.22.7, please confirm that the API exchange will be limited to state level systems and not available at the school or district level.
- A.2. Yes The API will be talking to the state central system.
- Q.3. Also per section A.22.7, is the two way communication related to demographics or does it mean assessment results coming back when the request is two way?
- A.3. It is more than demographics it also includes student information and assessment results as per 22.73 and 22.74.
- Q.4. Also, per section A.22.7, which entities from the specification are required to be supported (student information, school information, assessments, etc.)?
- A.4. All entities referenced are required. 22.71 22.75 are required to be supported.
- Q.5. Also per section A.22.7, what is the expected frequency of the data exchange?
- A.5. Varies depending on the type of data.
- Q.6. Is the requirement under A.52 for SIF the same as the requirement under A.22.7?
- A.6. Yes
