What is oral language?

The development of oral language skills means developing skills which strengthen speaking and listening. Oral language skills include; phonology, phonics, word study, fluency, vocabulary, and reading comprehension.

What are some strategies I can use at home?





Lenguaje Oral

¿Qué es el lenguaje oral?

El desarrollo de las habilidades del lenguaje oral significa desarrollar habilidades que fortalezcan el habla y la escucha. Las habilidades del lenguaje oral incluyen; fonología, fonética, estudio de palabras, fluidez, vocabulario y comprensión de lectura.

¿Cuáles son algunas estrategias que puedo usar en casa?

La conciencia de sonidos como sílabas y rimas es un componente importante en el desarrollo del lenguaje oral. Jugar un juego de rimas con su hijo puede aumentar su conocimiento de las rimas. Cuando esté fuera o en casa, desafíelos a pensar en tantas rimas para una palabra que les dé. (por ejemplo, ¿cuáles son todas las palabras que conoces que riman con perro?)

Conexión familiar

El lenguaje oral es un componente importante de la lectura y la escritura. Durante los primeros años de vida, los niños desarrollan habilidades de lenguaje oral que luego les ayudarán con la lectura y la escritura. Las familias pueden ayudar a fortalecer estas habilidades todos los días.
