## Subject: Driven-to-Read FREE Alternative Assessment

Based on Section 6-107.3, Title 47, of the Oklahoma Statutes, any person under the age of 18 years wishing to apply for a driver's license or permit must demonstrate a satisfactory reading ability at the eighth-grade level (unless the student is on an individualized education program [IEP] and performing satisfactorily in reading according to the IEP). Public school students must therefore successfully complete the eighth-grade state reading test or an alternative test approved by the State Department of Education.

In lieu of reimbursement, the State Department of Education has developed the **Grade 8 Alternative Reading Assessment**, provided at **no cost to the schools**. Schools may download this alternative reading test from the Single Sign On system in the WAVE. This test will be available on a continuous basis for future use but may be administered to a student only once per quarter.
