

Folding In Strategy

When do I use this strategy?
This strategy can be used when practicing sight words or letter names/sounds.

How do I use this strategy?

- 1. **C**reate 10 flashcards with 7 known words/letters/sounds and 3 unknown.
- 2. Shuffle the deck and present each card to student asking "What is this [letter, sound, word]?"
- 3. If the student can not name within 3 seconds it remains in the unknown pile.
- 4. When the student can complete the deck 3 sessions in a row, update the deck.
