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### **ACCESSING THE INDICATOR TOOL**

The continuum of alternative placements includes instruction in general education classes, special education classes, special schools, home instruction, and instruction in hospitals and institutions. In determining appropriate settings and services for a student with a disability, the IEP team considers the student's needs and the continuum of alternative placements, including supplementary aids and services available to meet those needs.

Regardless of placement, the student will be given appropriate access to the general education curriculum, as determined by the IEP team. LRE decisions are always made individually for each student and based on the student's unique, disability-related needs. Placement decisions are never based solely on the student's category of disability. The student's IEP is developed before the determination of the placement of services and settings. The services and settings needed for each student with a disability must be based on the student's IEP and unique needs that result from their disability, not on the student's category of disability.
