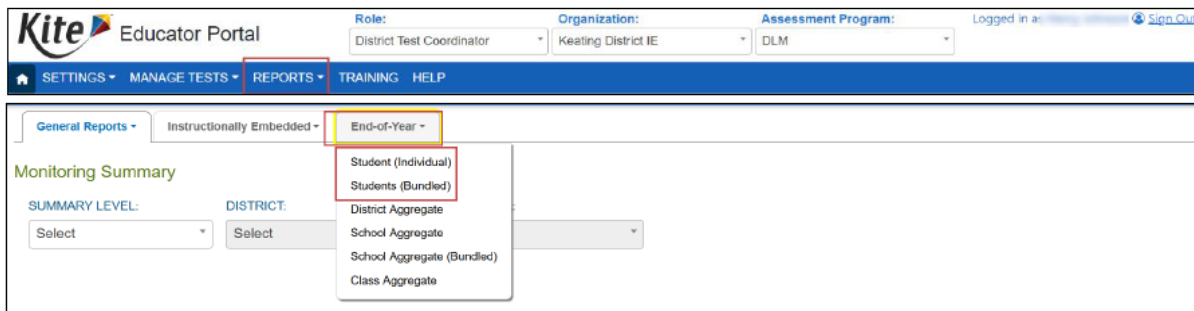

2023-2024 OAAP Handbook

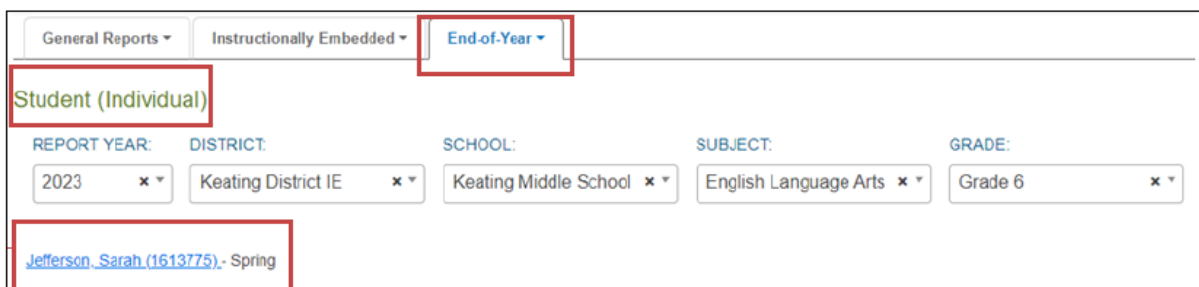
The [OAAP Handbook](#) is a new addition to the OAAP website. The handbook is broken into six sections covering OAAP information, criteria for OAAP, curriculum resources, navigating Kite Educator Portal, testing, and a question-and-answer section. We hope educators and district users will find this resource helpful.

Accessing Score Reports

Score Reports can be accessed in Kite Educator Portal in the **Reports** tab. Select **Alternate Assessment Reports, End-of-Year** tab, and select **Student (Individual)** or **Students (Bundled)**.



Complete the filters, then select a student's name to view the Individual Student Score Report.



Bundled Student Score Reports are sorted by grade, student last name, and subject.

2022-2023 Instructionally Embedded Assessment Window (Optional)

The Instructionally Embedded Assessment Window is open. Below are some important reminders about utilizing this highly encouraged, but optional assessment:

- Instructionally Embedded Assessments should guide instruction. Please do not have a student take assessments in each linkage level.
- Important Reminders:
 - Students do not need to assess on a linkage level until mastery.
 - Students do not need to be assessed on every linkage level for every Essential Element.
 - Students in the same class do not have to be assessed on the same Essential Elements.
 - Instructionally Embedded Assessments allow teachers to focus on each student individually and use the data to differentiate instruction.

- DLM has released a new training module “How to Interpret and Use Score Reports.” The module covers how to read and interpret the performance and learning profile, score report uses, and caution about score report interpretation and uses that are not supported by DLM.
