DTC- Kite Educator Portal Data Clean-Up

As the Instructionally Embedded Assessment Window is now closed, please go into Kite Educator Portal to ensure students are rostered to the correct subject areas. If you have students in Kite who are not eligible to participate in OAAP, they should be removed at this time.

Retrieving the DLM TIP Sheets

The spring assessments will go much smoother if teachers are prepared for the test by looking at the TIP sheets first. Remember, you may print the TIP sheets, but they must be destroyed after use as they are considered secure test materials. Training Status Report

DTCs can pull the Training Report in Kite Educator Portal to review and remind educators to complete their required training before the start of testing. In Kite Educator Portal select **Reports** and **Data Extracts**. Select the **Data Management** tab. The report that allows you to monitor the training completion is titled, **Training Status**. Spring Testing Window Reminders

- Test Administrator training is located in Kite Educator Portal under the **Training** section. All training must be completed before educators can access the testlets.
- The First Contact Survey and Personal Needs and Preferences Profile (PNP) should be completed by **March 20th** for testing to begin on **March 25th**. If educators wait until after the testing window opens, they will have to wait 24 hours after they complete the First Contact Survey and the PNP for the testlets to show up in Kite.
- Please check if the student's STN and grade level are accurate in DLM before the testing window opens on **March 25th**.
- DLM is an adaptive assessment with one testlet being available at a time for each subject. After the testlet is administered and submitted, the system requires about 15 minutes to score the testlet and determine the linkage level of the next testlet in the subject: the same linkage level, one above, or one below.
