

➤ OSDH VPN 101

The current status of using a virtual private network (VPN) for OSDH staff working remotely includes two options:

1. For staff using a state-issued laptop there is a VPN solution that is installed on the laptops. That is either “**NetMotion**” for current laptops or “**Pulse Secure**” for newer laptops. *Neither of those solutions are available to be loaded onto personal computers SoonerStart Visits by telephone.*
2. For staff using a state-issued desktop who have a personal computer at home, there is a web-based VPN solution (vpn.ok.gov) that uses a remote desktop protocol (RDP). This provides virtual access to the desktop with all the software and network drives that are currently used on the desktop. To use this option, the desktop must remain turned on.
