Literacy Resources

Home

- Gather a small collection of books from different genres so your child can explore a variety of reading materials. Many libraries offer free or low-cost books.
- Utilize environmental print to encourage your child to read, such as food labels, logos on t-shirts, street signs, etc.

Community

- A local library is a place to find books, e-books, and literacy programs for kids. They may have story time sessions, literacy workshops, or reading challenges offered for free. Bookstores may also offer literacy events for the community.

Online

- Many platforms offer free access to e-books and audiobooks. These are great for expanding the variety of reading material available to your child, especially if visiting the library is challenging.

Family Connection

Engaging with literacy outside of school helps strengthen your child's academic skills by offering more exposure and opportunities to learn. Hogar
