To Whom It May Concern:

I am writing on behalf of the Oklahoma Bible Academy. Founded in 1911, OBA offers a full course of study for grades 6 - 12.

Oklahoma Bible Academy is fully accredited by the Association of Christian Schools International. The A.C.S.I. accrediting body is a member of the Oklahoma Private Schools Accrediting Commission.

The OBA purpose is to provide a faith-based course of study based on the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments. The curriculum is college-preparatory and the general requirements for graduation are comparable to S.D.E. standards.

OBA enrolls students who have agreed to the Statement of Faith, have completed an application for admission. Each student and at least one parent is required to attend the admission interview. The OBA school official conducting the interview explains the resources and programs available for students with disabilities.

It is the desire of Oklahoma Bible Academy to be added to the approved list of private schools participating in the Lindsey Nicole Henry Scholarship program and to fully cooperate with the Oklahoma State Department of Education.
