English language arts teachers in grades 4th-8th need training to understand how to assist their students who are struggling readers. This is due to learning loss during the pandemic as well as other factors, some Oklahoma students in higher grades still need foundational reading skills. The first-grade students whose learning was disrupted in the 2019-2020 school year will be sixth graders in the 2024-2025 school year.

In addition, test scores demonstrate that Oklahoma middle school students cannot read texts written at their grade level. In spring of 2022, the Oklahoma State Testing Program (OSTP) revealed that 26% of Grade 6 students, 21% of Grade 7 students, and 25% of Grade 8 students performed at or above the Proficient level. The 2022 National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) revealed that only 21% of Grade 8 students in Oklahoma performed at or above the NAEP Proficient level.

By learning about phonological awareness, phonics, decoding, structural analysis, fluency, vocabulary, summarizing, and inferences, teachers will have the knowledge and confidence to assist their students who lack foundational reading skills. This science of reading training will accommodate up to 100 teachers per semester and can be renewed for up to five years, ending in June 2030.

If this project does not move forward, Oklahoma teachers and students will be deprived of learning and literacy skills, which are needed to enhance learning in all discipline areas. Once students learn to read, they begin to read to learn in their other subject areas. Oklahoma must secure a strong foundation for students so that they can have a brighter future.
