Standards-Based Assessment System Analysis

- In December 2018, Oklahoma Department of Education released a Request for Information (RFI) to assessment vendors of interim assessment programs commonly used within the state.
- Four assessment vendors responded with the requested information for ELA and mathematics:
 - Mastery Connect (Certica Item Bank)
 - Measured Progress (eMPower)
 - NWEA (MAP Growth)
 - Renaissance Learning (STAR)



RFI Response

 All assessment vendors claimed that their items were aligned to the Oklahoma Academic Standards but did not provide specific information about how they defined "alignment" with the standards or what specific criteria were used to evaluate alignment in the test development process.





- The study involved an analysis of the test program framework documentation provided by each assessment vendor and an **item-level content analysis**.
- External panelist ratings from the item-level analysis were compared with internally assigned metadata or internal coding associated with 100-item samples from grade 4 and grade 7 item banks.
- Note: this item review did <u>not</u> compare the interim assessments with the Oklahoma School Testing Program (OSTP) assessments.



Test Item-level Claims

- In the category of Alignment Claims, we report the claims made by each of the assessment programs regarding their alignment with various sets of standards, and any evidence they provide that undergird those claims.
- DOK Ranges are based on the DOK of the OAS. The standards set grade-level expectations and rigor as well as expectations for students to be college- and career-ready.






Grade 4 Math: Distribution of Items by Domain (per vendor coding of 100 item sample)





Grade 7 Math: Distribution of Items by Domain (per vendor coding of 100 item sample)





Conclusions

- Item-level analysis results varied by grade and/or subject.
- For ELA and mathematics, external reviewer agreement with test vendor DOK assignments varied from 50% to 98%.
- External reviewers found a close match with the test vendor standard correlation for 59% to 100% of ELA and mathematics items.



Conclusions

- Based on the item samples reviewed in this analysis, the assessment programs vary by grade, breadth of standards assessed, complexity of items, and other factors.
- Stakeholders can use the comparative information within this report to choose program(s) that are the best fit for the needs of their district.
