Expenditure	Allowable (Y/N)	Comments
Testing Kits	No	Each district will receive tests and PPE at no charge against the grant amount shown in GMS. Tests and PPE can be ordered through Oklahoma State Department of Health's Big Commerce site and will not impact your grant allocation. Ordering details will be provided upon confirmation of grant award. Medical supplies can be an allowable expense if District needs additional supplies greater than those to be supplied by OSDH.
PPE	Maybe	PPE can be ordered free of charge (not counted against grant award) but districts can order supplies if need is greater than those supplied by Oklahoma State Department of Health.
Medical Supplies	Yes	
Personnel	Yes but only for grant-related activities	<p>Unlike ARP ESSER funds, this grant cannot be used to supplant. For existing employees, districts may change job responsibilities to include grant-related activities. The compensation and benefits for the portion of time spent on grant-related activities is allowable. Nurse salaries and benefits. If a nurse spends 50% of their time on grant-related work, then 50% of salary and benefits would be an allowable cost.</p> <p>Grant may be used to pay overtime expenses.</p> <p>Stipends are not allowable per CDC, Oklahoma State Department of Health.</p> <p>*Timesheets and/or Time and Effort forms can be submitted for additional time spent on grant-related activities for employees.</p> <p>Districts may contract with visiting nurse companies, temporary employee agencies, or other contract personnel companies.</p> <p>Districts may hire new employees including nurses, contract tracers, administrative assistants to complete tracking and reporting, custodial staff, etc.</p>

Materials for communications (testing events, promoting mitigation activities, etc.	Yes	Printing, paper supplies, posters, banners, etc.
Vehicles	No but ... leases, yes	The grant will not reimburse for the purchase of any assets so districts may not purchase vans, SUVs, buses, etc. Districts may, however, lease a vehicle for the duration of the grant.
Portable air filtration systems	Yes	Any small appliance that increases air circulation is allowable. Complete HVAC systems or any capital expense related to climate controls/HVAC is not allowable. If a purchase would be a permanent fixture in a facility, it is not allowed.
Cameras for contract tracing	No	Not allowable per CDC and Oklahoma State Department of Health.
Water bottle fountains	No	Not allowable per CDC and Oklahoma State Department of Health.
Floor cleaning machines	No	Machine are considered asset purchases and are not allowable. Small portable machines with short life spans are allowable.
Remodel/Flooring	Maybe.	Only allowable if transforming another room into a testing site.
Telephone Messaging System	Yes	Allowable for use of automated messaging notifying staff/parents of exposure, quarantine etc.
Cell Phones	Yes	Allowable for use of grant-related activities.
Wall mounted Thermometers	Yes	Allowable per CDC, Oklahoma State Department of Education.
