St. Joseph Catholic School in Enid, Oidahoma declares its intention to participate in the Undsey Nicole Henry Scholarships for Students with Disabilities Program.

St. Joseph Catholic School is a fully accredited school through the Oklahoma Conference of Catholic Schools Accrediting Association and through reciprocal agreement by the Oklahoma State Department of Education via the Oklahoma Private School Accreditation Commission. St. Joseph's has been opened since 2001 and currently has 88 students enrolled in Pre-Kindergarten through Grade 5: All homercom teachers in Kindergarten through Grade 5 are certified teachers by the State of Oklahoma. All homercom teachers and administrators have at least three years of teaching experience.

St. Joseph Catholic School works with Enid Public School in providing speech therapy, special education tutoring, and ELL reading programs to qualified students. St. Joseph's adheres to the tenets of Title IX. Our Parent-Student Handbook states that "There shall be no discrimination in enrollment practices according to race, othnic background, socioeconomic status, or gender at St. Joseph Catholic School."

St. Joseph Catholic School currently has a \$468,000 operating budget. An independent auditor audits the school's financial records annually.

St. Joseph Catholic School works with Garfield County and the Enid Fire Department to ensure that the school meets health and safety codes. The school maintains an updated Crisis Management Handbook, and practices fire, tornado, evacuation, and lockdown procedures throughout the school year. St. Joseph's distributes and follows a school-wide disciplinary code.
