Special Education (SPED) Micro-credential certification pathway

Go live date: 5/31/22

Prerequisite:

Applicants must hold a five-year certificate in Mild-Moderate Disabilities

Process to obtain provisional certification:

- 1. School district administration/HR recommends an applicant online, via Single Sign-On (SSO), for a certificate in Severe-Profound Multiple Disabilities (SPMD).
- 2. Applicant logs into their Oklahoma Educator Credentialing System (OECS) where a notification to apply for this certificate will be present.
- 3. Applicant applies and pays \$50 fee online.
- 4. Applicant is issued a provisional certificate in SPMD, valid for up to two years.

Process to obtain standard certification:

- 1. During the term of the provisional certificate, applicant completes the OSDE approved SPED micro-credentialing program (call Michele DeBerry or Megan Horton @405-521-3351 in SPED for details)
- 2. When the program is satisfactorily completed, either Michele or Megan will recommend you for standard certification on OECS.
- 3. Applicant logs into their Oklahoma Educator Credentialing System (OECS) where a notification to apply for this certificate will be present.
- 4. Applicant applies and pays \$25 fee online to add SPMD to his/her standard certificate

NOTE: The provisional certificate is non-renewable
