



Steps for Creating Language Expectations from WIDA English Language Development Standards Framework and Identifying Language Features	
1.	Identify target <a href="#">Oklahoma Academic Standard(s)</a> .
2.	Determine <b>Key Language Use</b> in <a href="#">Oklahoma Academic Standard(s)</a> .
3.	Go to <a href="#">WIDA English Language Development Standards Framework</a> and locate <b>Grade Level Cluster</b> for identified <b>Key Language Use</b> for <b>Standard 1 Language for Social and Instructional Purposes</b> and identify <b>Language Functions</b> that coordinate with <a href="#">Oklahoma Academic Standard(s)</a> .
4.	Locate <b>Grade Level Cluster</b> for identified <b>Key Language Use</b> for WIDA's content English Language Development Standard 2-5 and identify <b>Language Functions</b> that coordinate with <a href="#">Oklahoma Academic Standard(s)</a> .
5.	Locate and choose sample <b>Language Features</b> for selected <b>Expressive Language Functions</b> based on students' needs.
6.	Unpack selected <b>Language Features</b> by homing in on key types of sentences, clauses, phrases, and words students will need to meet <a href="#">Oklahoma Academic Standard(s)</a> . (If you are unsure of what a <b>Language Feature</b> is referring to, please refer to the <b>Glossary</b> in the <a href="#">WIDA English Language D Standards Framework</a> ).
