SUGGESTED IMPLEMENTATION CALENDAR (YEAR ONE)

DESCRIPTION

This document is to help schools and districts implement the <u>Oklahoma Comprehensive</u> <u>School Counseling Framework</u>. This is meant to be a step-by-step process, as outlined below. Additionally, the <u>OSDE Connect Course</u> can aid in implementation.

AUG

SUGGESTED TRAINING VIDEOS

- <u>Comprehensive School Counseling</u> <u>Overview</u>
 - If the district has already received an introduction presentation, skip this step and only have new school counselors watch the introduction video
- <u>Creating Annual and Weekly</u>
 <u>Calendars</u>

SUGGESTED ACTIVITIES

- Complete Program Audit
- Begin drafting weekly calendar (one per school counselor)
 - Template for weekly calendar
- Begin drafting the annual calendar (one per school)
 - <u>Template for the annual</u> <u>calendar</u>
 - I recommend this activity be done by allowing school counselors to work with the other school counselors at their level (all elementary school counselors together, etc.). This will allow for collaboration between schools.

SUGGESTED TRAINING VIDEO

Annual Administrative Conference

SUGGESTED ACTIVITY

- Complete the Annual Administrative Conference by the end of September
- <u>Annual Administrative Conference</u> <u>Template</u>
 - I recommend this meeting be done by all school counselors in August/September every year.
 Even if you have to leave some of the parts blank on the form, starting this conversation is vital. It would be great if after all the school counselors have this meeting, they have time to process and share their successes and areas for growth for next year's meeting.
