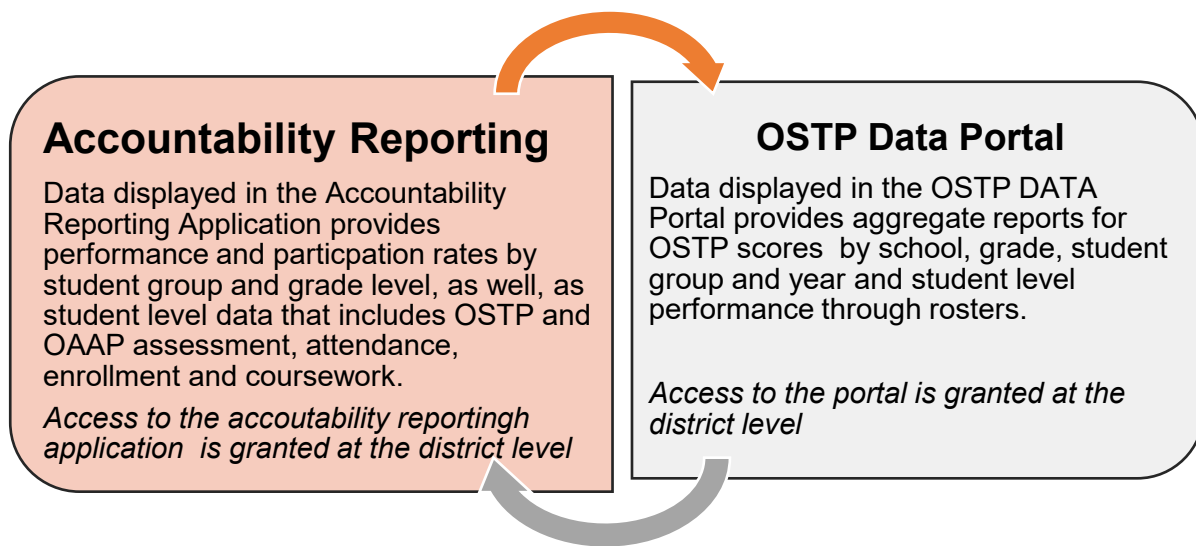


Connecting Participation Rates to OSTP Performance Data Toolkit

This year, it is particularly important to consider other information when interpreting state test scores from the 2021 school year administration. **We urge caution when examining summary reports because of the possibility of uneven participation rates or because of changes to learning conditions that may have been disrupted by the pandemic.** The standard participation threshold is 95%. When participation falls below that level, inferences about overall performance are uncertain. Therefore, we ask that you start your review by examining participation rates across student groups in the [Accountability Reporting](#) application in Single Sign-On before reviewing performance data aggregates in the [OSTP Data portal](#).

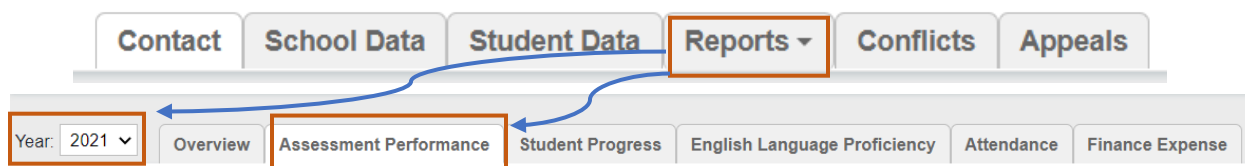


Participation Rates in the Accountability Reporting Application

As shown in the graphic, the Accountability Reporting Application provides important context to data provided in the OSTP Data Portal by displaying participation rates. To connect your participation rates, sign into your Single Sign-On account and then choose [Accountability Reporting](#).

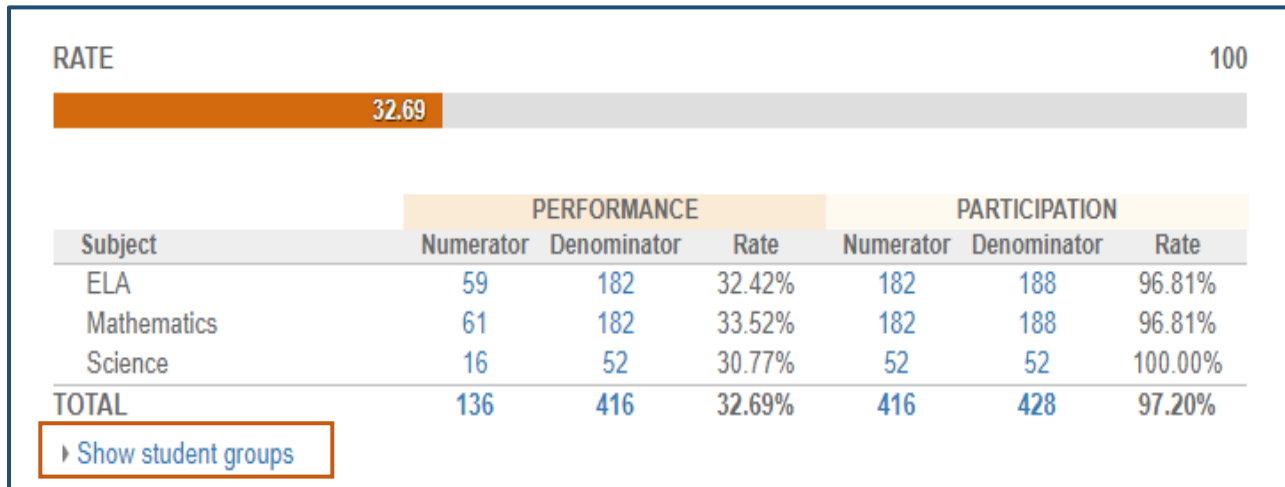


From [Accountability Reporting](#), click on **REPORTS**, choose **Contextual Data** from the drop-down menu and then choose **Assessment Performance** for **Year 2021**.

This will open a page that displays your overall and subject level performance and participation rates.



Data displayed here were aggregated from data displayed on the Student Assessment tab and reviewed during the Assessment Data Verification Review (DVR) window.

What the data relates:

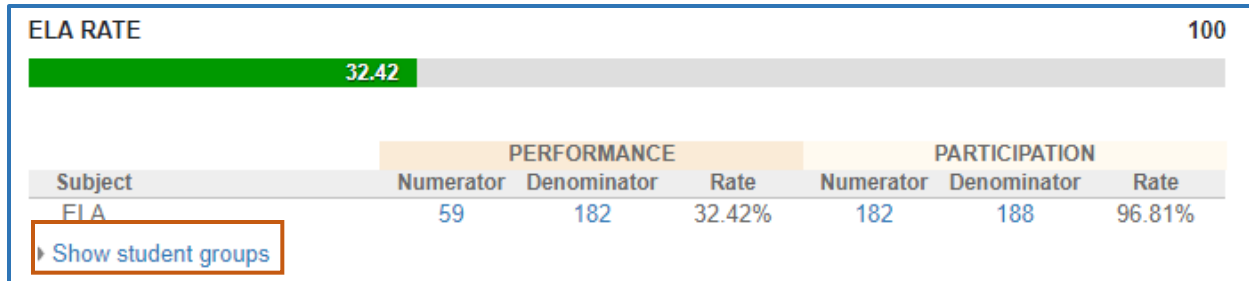
- **Rate-** the overall percentage of students demonstrating readiness across all subjects
- **Performance Numerator** - the number of students ready for the next grade or course as demonstrated by scoring at or above the proficient cut of 300.
- **Performance Denominator-** the Number of students that tested
- **Performance Rate-** the percentage of students ready for the next grade or course as demonstrated by scoring at or above the proficient cut point of 300
- **Participation Numerator** the number of students with a valid test score from OSTP, CCRA or OAAP
- **Participation Denominator** – The number of students enrolled at time of testing and expected to test
- **Participation Rate-** The percentage of students that participated in testing and answered enough questions to have a valid score.

Subject Participation Rates by Student Group

To display participation rates by student group, click on **Show student groups**



This will expand the display to show participation rates for each student group and grade level.

Click on the **Denominator** used to calculate participation to display the student records for students that were enrolled at the time of testing. The number of records for each filter is displayed at the top of the spreadsheet.

- Use the **Grade Level** filter to review grade level participation.
- Use the **No Score Code** filter to identify students that did not test.
 - Click on the **Student's STN** to connect other information about students that did not test such as enrollment and attendance.
