- Oklahoma Core Curriculum Tests (OCCT)
 - Grades 3-8 and EOI
- Oklahoma Modified Alternate Assessment Program (OMAAP)
 - ONLY for EOI Second Time Testers with a previous score
- Oklahoma Alternate Assessment Program (OAAP)
 - Grades 3-8 and EOI

- Every student enrolled in a tested grade level in an Oklahoma public school must participate in testing.
- All students will be administered either an
 - OCCT general assessment with or without accommodations or
 - Alternate assessment.
 - OMAAP with or without accommodations (limited to second time testers and EOI)
 - OAAP

- District Test Coordinator (DTC)
 - Responsible for making arrangements for testing
 - Handles and maintains the secure distribution and collection of test materials
 - Security of all testing information and material is crucial.
 - Must be trained by State Department during Test-Preparation In-Service
 - Training must be validated each school year.

- District Test Coordinator (DTC)
- Trains Building Test Coordinators, Test
 Administrators, Test Proctors and other key staff
 - Test administrators are required to be Oklahoma certified teachers employed by the district.
 - Proctors are required for every 25-35 students.

 - Assessing new College and Career Readiness Standards

- Provided through Acuity, a subsidiary of CTB
