### STEM BLOCKS:

Course eligibility as a stem block course, allowable as a math or science credit for the core curriculum pathway towards graduation, must meet the minimum requirements set for science or mathematics courses. Such courses must be aligned to the competencies at or above the rigor of biology I and algebra I, respectively. Courses not including mathematics or science content must include sets of competencies within computer education. Any course only addressing engineering, without the inclusion of science, mathematics, or computer education content, is not eligible.

### GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS:

Courses should be transcribed reflecting the courses the competencies covered. Ex: A concurrent enrollment course taken should be coded to the HS course. 5641 Psychology (OSU/Intro to Psy.) if you are embedding courses, both sets of competencies must be covered and both courses should be reflected on the transcript with credit/grade earned.
