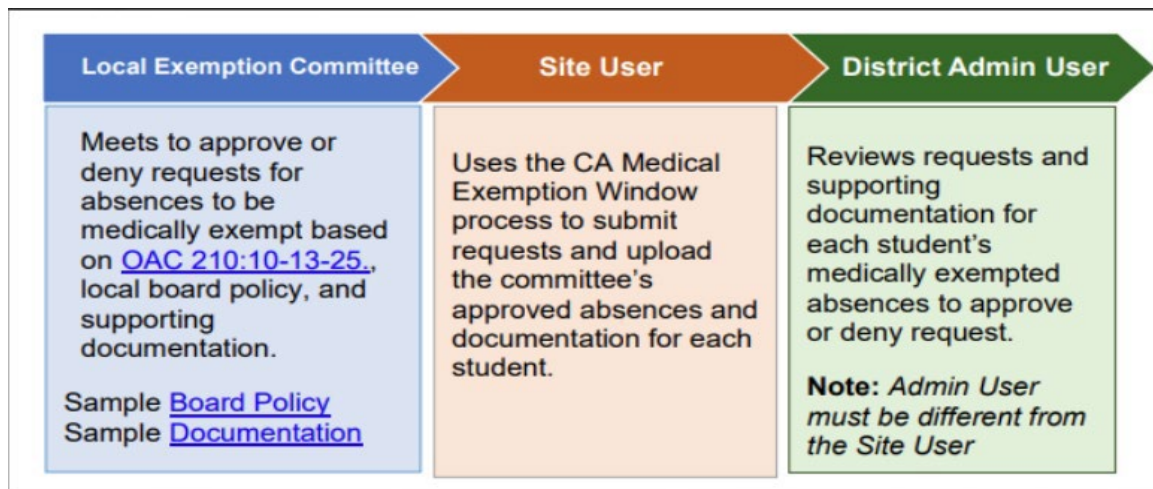

Accountability Reporting

- Currently Open
 - Chronic Absentee Medical Exemption – Now Open Closes 6/30/23
 - Open through the end of the school year.

Accountability Reporting

- If you have students that left your district for SY 2023 prior to October 1st and you used the wrong exit code creating a dropout. You can correct that exit code since we are in the current year in your SIS.
- Examples of this would be out-of-state transfers, homeschooling, and private school transfers. Since these are current-year students, you must update their exit codes in your Student Information System (SIS).

Accountability Reporting

- Postsecondary Coursework Credit.
- Now is the time to check in the Accountability Reporting Application to ensure your grades are posting correctly for Postsecondary Credit.
- Check on your conflict tab and school data conflict, for issues related to Post Secondary Credit. (Instruction level code).

Annual Statistical Review (ASR)

- Opened on 03/01/2023 Closes on 6/30/2023
- Clear Ownership conflicts and data validation errors.
- Check calendars and make sure you are meeting your school day requirement of 165 total days to include 158 days of instruction, 2 PT, and 5 professional days minimum.
- Enter your graduate exit codes and exit dates before certifying your ASR.
- Contact State Aid (405)521-3460.

P-EBT SY 2022

- Timelines

- March 13-April 15 (4 weeks)
 - Parent online submission form for PEBT issues.
- March 20-April 28 (6 weeks)
 - DVR window open for districts.
- End of May
 - Final SY2022 and Summer file to DHS.

P-EBT SY 2022

- Communications will be sent to qualifying districts next week for them to communicate to parents about the parent online form. The form can be accessed at <https://sde.ok.gov/pebt>.
- OSDE will provide a template that each district can use to message the parents. It will be very important to communicate this quickly as our timeline is very short. You can do this by email or posting a message to your website.
- Parents will only have a 4-week period to make submissions.

P-EBT SY 2022

- OSDE will send a weekly spreadsheet to the districts.
- The spreadsheet will only contain parent requests for each week.
- Districts can begin validating site-wide calendar distance learning/virtual days and creating DVRs for those starting on March 20th.
- Districts can also validate virtual and blended students and create DVRs if needed to correct the basis of admission code of RVON or RVOFF. This may resolve some of the parent's requests proactively.

P-EBT SY2022

- How does a district qualify for P-EBT SY 2022?
 - The district must have 5 consecutive site-wide distance learning or virtual days due to COVID in SY 2022 or your district must have 5 consecutive days of declining attendance due to COVID in SY 2022.

P-EBT SY 2022

- OSDE will provide district guidance to assist with the different DVR types that should be created for each circumstance prior to March 20th.
- Parents are required to provide the student's 10-digit STN and will be directed to the district for this information.

P-EBT SY2022

- Below are the questions and options the parent will see.

- MORE INFORMATION

My student did not get a P-EBT card for the 2021-2022 school year. I believe my student should have received a card because:

- My student attended school virtually.
- My student had an approved meal application (free/reduced meals).
- My student had some distance learning days.
- Other

My student did get a P-EBT card for the 2021-2022 school year, but I do not believe the amount is correct because:

- Another child in my household received a larger amount.
- My student had more distance learning days than were counted.
- Other

My student did not get a P-EBT card for summer 2022. I believe my student qualifies because:

- My student was enrolled in this school during May 2022.
- My student had an approved meal application.
- Other

- We will include this in the guidance and indicate the type of DVR you will use for each response.

Transfers

- Incoming open transfer results for Q3 and district capacity for Q4 reporting will open on March 17th and close on April 17th.
- Approved transfer extension may be acted upon May 1st through May 31st.
- Applications for the 23/24 school year will not be made available until June 1, 2023. You will not be able to approve those requests until July 1, 2023.
