Commenter suggests several grammatical changes to (a)(5)(B)(i),(a)(6)(F), (a)(7), and (a)(8)(A)	The agency has implemented the proposed changes.
Commenter expressed concerns regarding (a)(6)(F), which states "If a district fails to complete or incorrectly complete answer documents and/or demographic pages or other required testing-related materials, the district may be penalized with additional costs and may also receive a deficiency on the district accreditation report." Commenter states: "Although we realize that no changes are proposed to this section, the current wording is confusing and wrong. As written, the language provides that if a district fails to [complete or] incorrectly complete answer documents, etc., it may be penalized."	This section is necessary to ensure districts accurately and thoroughly complete testing forms and comply with the instructions set forth in the test preparation manuals. Failure to correctly complete these forms (e.g., incorrect Student Testing Number) results in delays in reporting assessment scores and calculating reports in accordance with the requirements of the Oklahoma School Testing Program.
